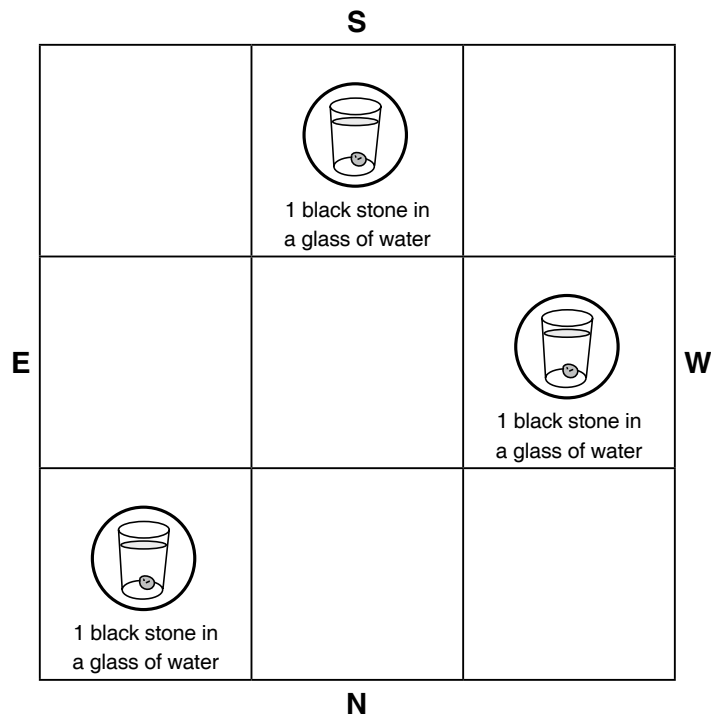

Special Feng Shui Setups for the Year of the Tiger

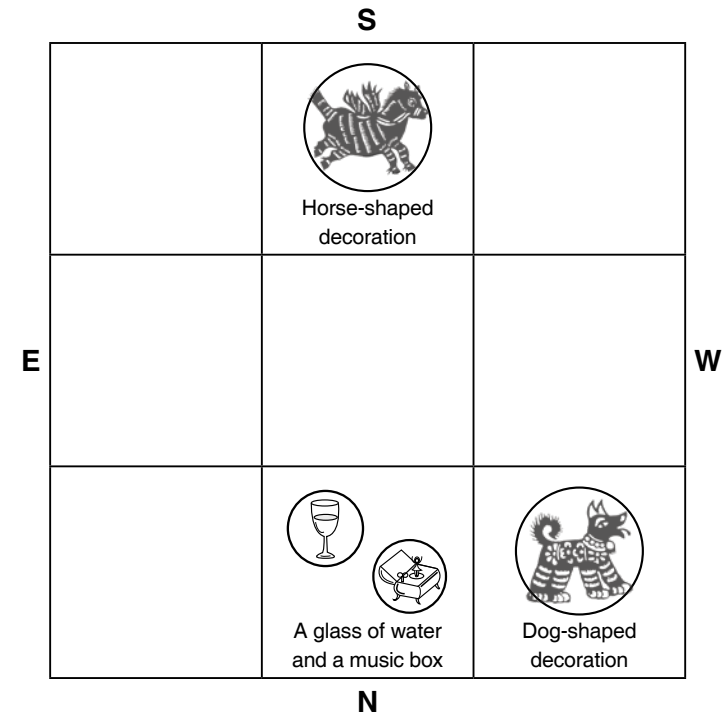
1. *Enhancing the luck of wealth*

Jiu Zi 九紫, the star of joyful events, falls in the South grid; Qi Chi 七赤 in the West; and the star of wealth Ba Bai 八白 in the Northeast. To boost your luck of wealth, you can put a glass of water with one black stone in it in each of those directions. Yet, such setup cannot be used permanently. You have to take a month's break after 3 months for it to stay effective.



2. *Enhancing general human relations and love luck*

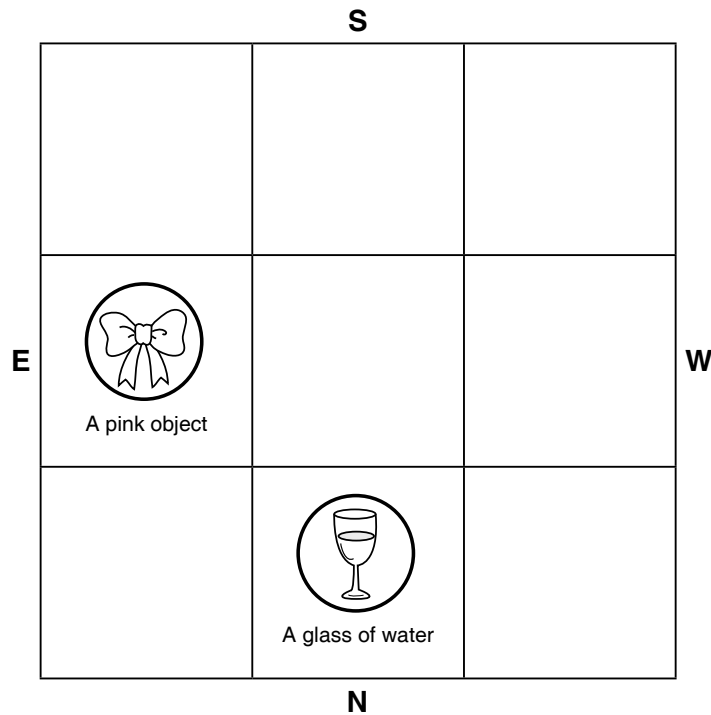
The direction of relationship is in the North while the directions in triple union with the presiding god are in the South and Northwest. For love luck, you can put a glass of water and a music box in the North grid of your house. For better general human relations, you may put a horse-shaped decorative piece in the South grid, and a dog-shaped decorative piece in the Northwest. Of course you can have both love luck and good interpersonal relationship if you do both. If you decide you don't need any more love luck (say, if you're married) but you need good interpersonal relationship, you might skip the music box in the North grid.



Enhancing the Household Luck and Health with Different Door Mats

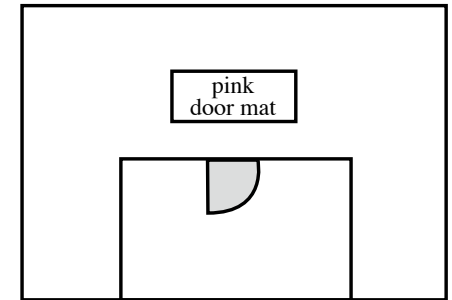
7. Boosting interpersonal relations and warding off gossips

Put a glass of water in the North grid (the direction of relationship) to boost your interpersonal relations, and a pink object in the East grid (the direction of gossips and arguments) to curb the gossipy energy.



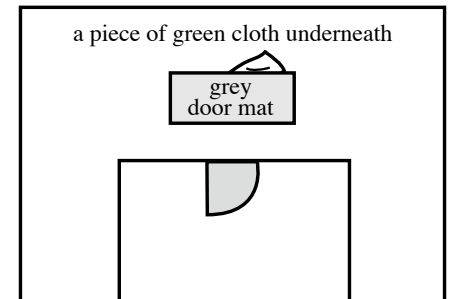
The East (main door in the East grid)

This is the direction of gossips and fights. You can put a pink door mat inside or outside the main door to resolve.



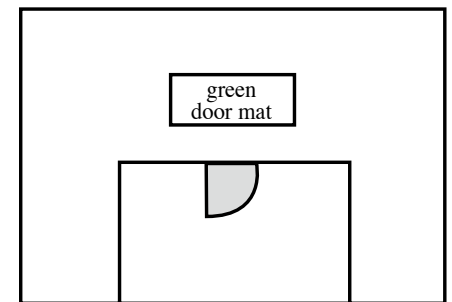
The Southeast (main door in the Southeast grid)

It is the direction of intellectual achievement this year. You can put a piece of green cloth beneath a grey door mat to boost such luck. (You can put it inside or outside the door for the same effect.)



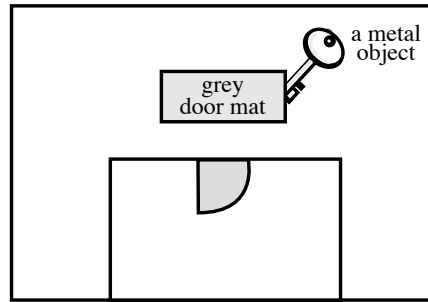
The South (main door in the South grid)

It is the direction of joyful events this year. You can put a green mat outside the main door to boost such luck. Or a red door mat inside the main door would do the same.



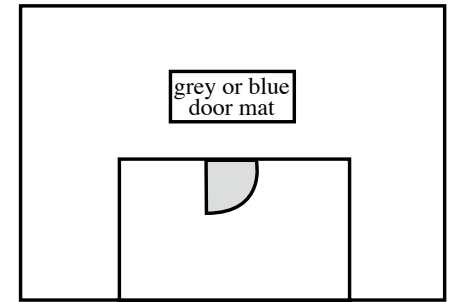
The Southwest
(main door in the Southwest grid)

It is the direction of minor sickness. You can use a grey door mat at the main door and put a metal object underneath it to resolve the energy of sickness. (You can put them inside or outside the door for the same effect.)



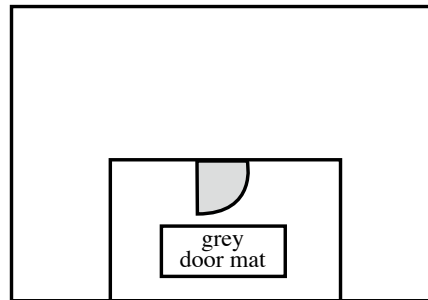
The North
(main door in the North grid)

This is the direction of relationship with Yi Bai—白 in. You can put a grey or blue door mat outside the main door to boost your love luck. If you don't want any more love relationship, put a green door mat inside the door, or a brown door mat outside.



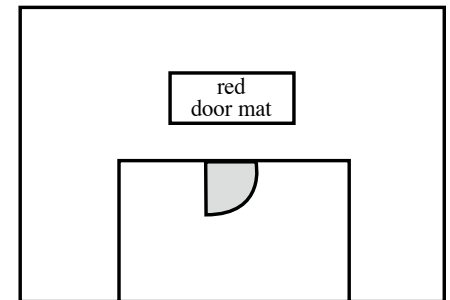
The West
(main door in the West grid)

It is where the former star of wealth Qi Chi七赤 is. Use a grey door mat inside the door to usher in wealth.



The Northeast
(main door in the Northeast grid)

This is the direction of wealth with the star Ba Bai八白 occupying the spot. You can use a red door mat outside the main door to boost your luck of wealth.



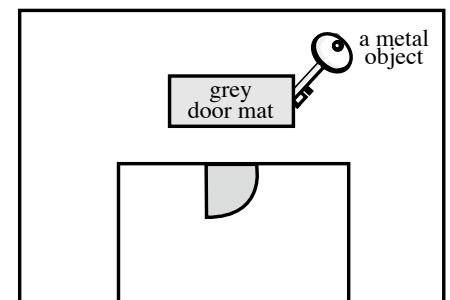
The Northwest
(main door in the Northwest grid)

The star of courage and military ability falls in this direction and it's a lucky direction for those having a non-clerical or outdoor job. You may put a yellow or brown door mat outside the door for better chance of promotion. Otherwise, you may put a grey door mat inside the door to enhance your luck of wealth.



The Centre
(main door in the Centre grid)

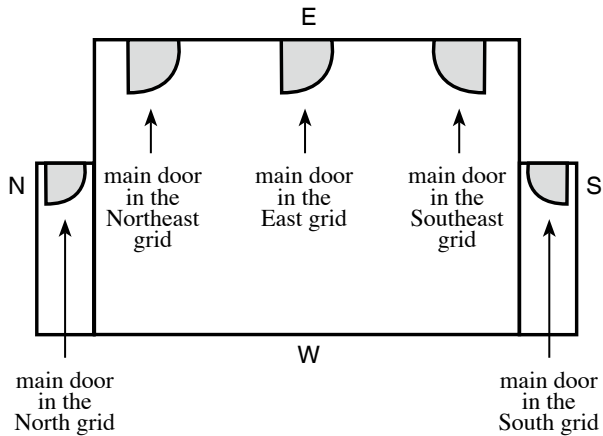
This is the direction of major sickness. You can use a grey door mat and put a metal object beneath it. Then hang wind chimes or put a music box inside the door to resolve the sick energy.

Cold predisposition – those born after 8 August and before 6 March of the following year in Western calendar (i.e. after the Beginning of Autumn and before Jing Zhe 驚蟄 in Lunar calendar)

Hot predisposition – those born after 6 May and before 8 August in Western calendar (i.e. after the Beginning of Summer and before the Beginning of Autumn in Lunar calendar)

Neutral predisposition – those born after 6 March and before 6 May in Western calendar (i.e. after Jing Zhe 驚蟄 and before the Beginning of Summer in Lunar calendar)



The Tigers were blessed by the powerful star of relationship Hong Luan 紅鸞 in 2021. It's only natural that you had chances of getting married, conceiving a child or giving birth to a baby last year. In case you didn't tie the knot in 2021, you should try even harder this year as your offence against the presiding god tends to bring changes, and nuptials are considered this kind of changes. The Chinese believe that "one joyful event pre-empts three mishaps-to-be; without joyful event, you'd feel depressed and sad". Those of you who have been dating for some time are likely to break up if you're not getting married this year. If you (or your partner) got pregnant in 2021, you'll welcome a new member

to your family in 2022. According to statistics, it's actually very common for people to get married, conceive or deliver a baby in their years of offence against the presiding god. As an experienced astrologist, I personally have come across countless times when parents' zodiacs are in conflicts with or the same as their children's.

In case you don't expect to have any joyful events in 2022, the Tigers should brace themselves for emotional problems. Your offence against the presiding god tends to trigger unexplained bad mood and pessimism. Those 36-year-old Tigers would take the hardest blow, followed by those 48-year-old Tigers. Even those 12-year-old Tigers are mature enough to be bothered by emotional problems in this modern era. Thus, Tigers aged 12, 36 or 48 should remind yourself to relax and take it easy this year. Don't push yourself too hard. If possible, go on a trip in Lunar January to take the edge off. Those with Cold predisposition should go East or South, whereas those with Hot or Neutral predisposition should go West or North. Make sure you don't go in the wrong direction. Otherwise, the trip would just undermine your luck further. On the other hand, those 60-year-old Tigers should take good care of their body. Check if your mouth is well shaped. In case your lips are crooked and darkly coloured, your front teeth are crooked, or if you have lost all your front teeth, you should pay extra attention to your health. Schedule a body check early. In addition, your offence against the presiding god means you're also susceptible to accidents and injuries. Thus, it's advisable to donate blood or get your teeth cleaned by a dentist in Lunar January and July, so as to realize the destined bloodshed in your fate and pre-empt any real injury. Other older Tigers should also take care of themselves. Watch your steps and avoid getting tripped and falling.

This is a year of good wealth for the Tigers. If you can handle your emotions well this year, you're likely to reap good profit and accumulate substantial wealth. On the down side, this is a transition year when the Water and Fire energies swap their dominance. No matter what predisposition you have, everyone is subject to unpredictable changes in terms of luck. Those with Hot or Neutral predisposition may start





seeing their luck wane from the summer of 2022 onwards. Some of you may hold on to your good luck until the end of 2024 at most. Those with Cold predisposition are supposed to see their luck turn around for the better in 2022, but your offence against the presiding god may dampen your progress. Therefore, if you're not too anxious to start your venture or make a career move, wait till 2023 or 2025 to put your plan into action. Your good luck will last till the summer of 2028 or 2031, depending whether your luck turns around in 2022 or 2025.

In your constellation, there isn't any lucky star at all. That means you're pretty much on your own in your year of offence. Don't expect others to help you.

On the down side, the unlucky star Jian Feng 劍鋒 and Fu Shi 伏屍 are shining on you this year. They just follow the zodiac sign that offends the presiding god each year, and they bring metal cuts and bloodshed. That's why all those who offend the presiding god should use extra care to prevent accidents when using any form of transportation. You're especially likely to get injured in Lunar January and July when you're reminded to pay utmost attention. Motorists should of course stay vigilant at all times behind the wheel.

The star Tai Sui 太歲 is just the same thing as offending the presiding god. We have discussed its impacts in the paragraphs that precede.

The stars Pi Tou 披頭 and Di Sha 地煞 are not particularly fierce this year and you can simply ignore them.



Cold predisposition – This is the first year of Wood-Fire dominance and your streak of good luck would last for six years. You can benefit from it and your luck will get better by the day. From 2025 to 2027 in particular, the Fire energy gets even stronger and your good luck would get a major boost further. Even if you're not in the major luck of your life yet, you can still achieve some satisfactory results solely relying on

your luck in each year. In other words, if you have ideas on new plans or urges to make a career change, the time is likely to be ripe from this year onwards.

Hot predisposition – Your streak of good luck finally comes to an end. From this year on, you should slow down your pace and act more conservatively. Your good luck may start to wane from the summer of 2022, while some of you may be able to hold on to it until the end of 2024. Just review the past few years of your life and determine whether your luck started turning good in 2016 or 2019. If your streak of good luck only started in 2019, you'd hold on to it till 2024.

Neutral predisposition – You're said to have stable luck all your life, but you'd still benefit from the Metal-Water dominance in the past six years. From this year on, the Wood-Fire energy sets in and your luck would start to wane. Though you won't experience obvious ups and downs in life like those with Hot or Cold predisposition, you'll still be able to feel the minor ebb and flow. Just brace yourself – from this year on, things wouldn't be as easy as before.



Born in 1938 – You have to work hard for money on your own. Though you're not getting any younger, you're still able and energetic. You should try your best to stay connected with the community despite your age. As your body can still handle it, just spend more time out and explore the world.

Born in 1950 – You don't feel like working hard and you'd take it easy. After working hard your whole life, it's time to take a break and slow down your pace. Enjoy your life and take it easy.

Born in 1962 – You'd get hold of more power and climb the social ladder. However, at your age, you're not likely to make a huge leap in career terms unless you're an entrepreneur managing your own business. Maybe there's a new member to your family, so that you'd climb in seniority in the family tree, or you're being more respected.
